What is a Title I School?

Our school is a Title I school. Title I schools receive funding from the federal government to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic content and student academic achievement standards.

Floyd County Schools uses this Title I funding to support schools with the highest percentages of students eligible for free and reduced lunch. Nine schools in our system benefit from Title I funds.

Assessments

At our school, your child will participate in the following assessments:

Georgia Milestones Assessment System is for students in Grades 3 through high school. It measures how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted standards in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

MAP Growth is for students in Grades K-12. It measures achievement and growth in math, reading, language arts, and science.

ACCESS for ELLs is for students in our English Learner Program whose first language is something other than English. This test measures the English Learners' proficiency in English.

Alternate Assessments are available for students with significant cognitive disabilities.
